GREETINGS FELLOW PAST PRESIDENTS, I TRUST YOU HAVE BEEN ABLE TO SETTLE DOWN AFTER THE HECTIC FESTIVE SEASON AND RESUMED NORMAL DUTIES FOR 2024.

The results of our postal voting regarding Membership changes are in, and the result is in favour of offering Social membership to all registered bowlers.

For members information the results were - 136 in favour of Social Members, 34 against and 1 informal. This was a 171 response of the 227 that were mailed out to full members.

The Executive Committee at their meeting Monday has agreed with the draft Constitution and we now provide you with a copy so that all members have the opportunity to study it and in due course accept it or propose any change(s) that they may wish.

We had initially intended for the acceptance of the new Constitution to be made on the 12th February at a Special General Meeting, however we are conscious of the need for members to have sufficient time to study the proposal and make any suggestions that they may want. It was therefore decided that the adoption of the new Constitution will now take place at our next Annual General Meeting to be held on Sunday 8th September in the Lower North Branch area – venue to be decided.

This will take care of the formalities however the Executive Committee has agreed that all Branches may now offer Social Membership to any registered bowler and it is recommended that that membership be along the same lines as that of an Associate member. This you will see is included in the draft Constitution.

It is hoped that this option will open the door for some new members but it is imperative that current members take every opportunity to invite past Club Presidents to join as well as those bowlers who would enjoy the fellowship and enjoyment of a great, inexpensive social game of bowls and with the opportunity to meet fellow bowlers from other areas of the State.

It is your Association and it can only grow with your help.

Should any member wish to discuss the proposal or any other concern they may have regarding our Association I am more than happy to receive correspondence or phone calls as I strive to 'keep the bowls rolling'.
