- Players are required to arrive at the venue 30 minutes prior to the starting time
- Team Captains are required to pay for the Team lunches (\$25.00 per player) at the time of morning registration
- Roll up ends are NOT PERMITTED
- NO DEAD ENDS: re-spot the jack on the center line 2m mark
- Two points will be awarded for a game win and One point for a drawn game
- Winners will be decided by :-
 - 1. The team scoring the most points. If scores are tied:-
 - 2. Shots up. If score still tied:-
 - 3. Percentage

In the case of a forfeit, the team receiving the forfeit will be awarded two points plus 8 shots All players must be financial members of the Bowls Past Presidents Association

Players are required to wear the Association shirt or a plain white shirt
